

## Military Order Number 41 of 1908

The Australian Intelligence Corps has been established for the purpose of:

- a. The training of officers and other ranks in intelligence work for both peace and war and supplying officers for intelligence positions at manoeuvres and in war.
- b. Collecting information about the topography of the Commonwealth and its dependencies and their military resources in personnel, material and means of communication.
- c. Collecting like information about foreign countries especially those in the Pacific.
- d. Preparing strategical and tactical maps and plans.
- e. Compiling and recording all information ready for immediate use.
