

# CEW BEAN PRIZE

## 2025 CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The biennial CEW Bean Prize for Military History is awarded jointly to the best Honours, Master and PhD theses submitted to any Australian university focusing on the history of the Australian Army.



The prize consists of:

- \$500 in cash
- Inscribed medallion
- Return airfares for the winner to attend the 2025 Chief of Army History Conference
- Presentation of the award at the Chief of Army History Conference dinner.

## Eligibility Criteria



To be eligible for the Prize you must have:

- Submitted your thesis in the past three years to an Australian university
- Focused your thesis on Australia military history
- Not submitted your thesis to the Prize previously.

Honours, Masters and PhD theses will be examined separately. The Prize will be judged by two external examiners appointed by the Australia Army History Unit.

All applicants will be notified of the outcome at the conclusion of assessment.
