

## KSSS AREA AND CONDUCT BRIEF

1. Welcome to the Army Recruit Training Centre, the Home of the Soldier, and the KSSS. The KSSS is one of the few remaining truly national Defence competitions, designed to unite our fellow service men and women through good spirited competition. For the competition to be a success, however, all teams have to be aware of the importance of their conduct whilst being housed in ARTC. All participants are reminded that they are representing their unit and their service, and that their conduct should reflect this.

2. First and foremost, ARTC is a high profile training institution for all recruits for the Australian Army. The intake of recruits during the summer months is generally very high and presents a high amount of activity. It is important that the competition in no way disturbs our primary function here at Kapooka (recruit training). **Therefore under no circumstances, are team members allowed to enter any buildings or areas not directly parts of the KSSS, in particular anywhere near the recruit's lines. A map of ARTC is attached to avoid any confusion.**

3. For those personnel that have been rationed in for the weekend, meals will be provided for in the Staff section of the main mess. This building is indicated on your map; with entry being from the north-east (sign posts are readily visible). Timings for meals are as follows:
